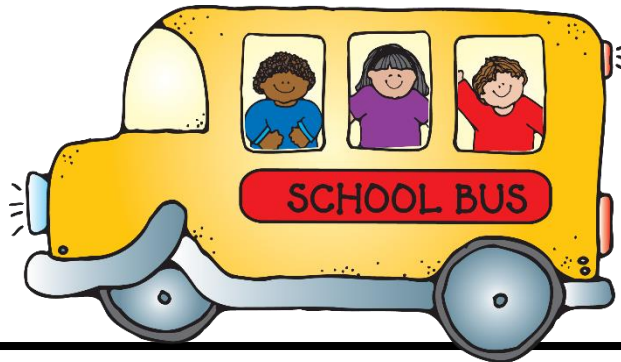

MATH: Ten Frames & Number Sense

- 1.1C – Select tools, including real objects, manipulatives, paper and pencil, and technology as appropriate, and techniques, including mental math, estimation, and number sense as appropriate, to solve problems
- 1.2A – Recognize instantly the quantity of structured arrangements
- 1.2B – Use concrete and pictorial models to compose and decompose
- 1.2C – Use objects, pictures, and expanded and standard forms to represent numbers to 120

SOCIAL STUDIES:

1.11B (i) – Develop drafts in oral, pictorial, or written form by organizing with structure

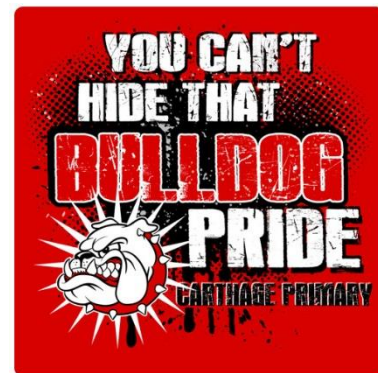
